4. Fire Department Report:

- Ch. Kuznik presented highlights. One call had a 20-minute response, this was a WCSO call in the beginning and our crews were on standby.
- o AP Triton final report received.
 - 37 recommendations in the report staffing, capital improvements (Station 4 and Station 5, replace two fire engines, update fleet repair services building, EMS service improvement)
 - There was a question about consolidation three options maintain status quo, form an authority, or form a new district.
 - Feasibility study \$20k to fund a study for consideration. (Joint Powers Authority)
 - Research from Community Development the City is not actively pursuing annexation; it is reliant on property owners requesting annexation.
 - A Community Risk Assessment will be completed, based on growth estimates in both City and Western Hills. Average response time over three years is approx. 12 minutes. One way to improve response times is to have a staffed station in Western Hills District. As City gets busier, it impacts response in Western Hills. In some stations, 20% of the time, the station responding in its area is not available to respond to another call in its area. May need to consider adding units to the system for example Alternative Response Units. Future responses increase need to be considered. There may be ways to enhance service delivery.
